



EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2020, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Marlin, Texas issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for the City of Marlin, Texas, resulting from COVID-19 (novel coronavirus).

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and

WHEREAS, §418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period of excess of seven days without the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; Also see The Texas Government Code §418.108(f),(g),(i)

WHEREAS, the Marlin City Council originally approved an extension of the local disaster declaration for the City of Marlin on April 14, 2020, until April 30, 2020, at midnight;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY EXECUTIVE ORDER OF THE MAYOR, OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS:

1. That the declaration of disaster proclaimed for the City of Marlin, Texas, by the Mayor and City Council on March 17, 2020 be extended until May 7, 2020, at midnight, it shall continue in effect until such time as the Covid-19 Disaster Declaration issued by Texas Governor Greg Abbott on March 13, 2020, expires or is withdrawn, unless sooner terminated by executive order of the Mayor.

2. This declaration was passed as an emergency measure and pursuant to Section 418 of the Texas Government Code and by virtue of the authority vested in me by Art. I, Sec. 1.05 of the Marlin City Charter and in conjunction with adopted City Ordinance No. 05-25 National Incident Management System {NIMS) as the standard for incident management for the City of Marlin and shall become effective on the 30th day of April, 2020.

3. Per State of Texas Governor Greg Abbott, Schools will remain under COVID 19 status until further notice from the Office of the Governor.
