The Marlin Police Department is proactive in the community, and conducts patrols throughout the city and traffic enforcement. Officers work 12-hour shifts with every other weekend off. We have a strong relationship with the Falls County Sheriff Department, Falls County District Attorney Office as well as the surrounding cities.

Marlin is located 30 miles Southeast of Waco and has a population of approximately 6,000 residents. State Highway 6 and State Highway 7 runs through the City Limits. Marlin is approximately 4.6 square miles.
