

RESOLUTION No. 14-031

**A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS DESIGNATING THE 2015 CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAYS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Marlin personnel policy states that the Mayor and City Council will annually designate the official paid holidays that are to be observed by the City of Marlin; and

**WHEREAS**, it is customary for the holidays that fall on Saturday to be taken Friday and those that fall on Sunday to be taken Monday; and employees required to work a shift on the holiday will be provided extra compensation as set out in the personnel policy, and

**WHEREAS**, employees who are members of religious faiths which celebrate widely recognized religious holidays that are not City holidays, as approved by supervisor, may take leave for those days and charge such against annual vacation leave.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council that the following dates are hereby designated as official paid Holidays for the City of Marlin, Texas:

January 1, 2015	Thursday	New Year's Day
January 19, 2015	Monday	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
February 16, 2015	Monday	President's Day
April 3, 2015	Friday	Good Friday
May 25, 2015	Monday	Memorial Day
June 19, 2015	Friday	Juneteenth
July 3, 2015	Friday	Independence Day
September 7, 2015	Monday	Labor Day
November 11, 2015	Wednesday	Veteran's Day Observation
November 26-27, 2015	Thursday/Friday	Thanksgiving Day/Day After
December 24-25, 2015	Thursday/Friday	Christmas Eve/Christmas Day

Two additional personal leave days will be provided for the 2015 calendar year.
