

ORDINANCE No. 15-014

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THE RESULTS OF A GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD IN THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS ON THE 9TH DAY OF MAY 2015, FOR THE ELECTION OF ONE (1) MAYOR-AT-LARGE, AND ONE (1) COUNCILMEMBER PRECINCT 5; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of May 2015, the City Council of the City of Marlin, Texas, at a Special Called Council Meeting, canvassed the returns of the General Municipal Election held on the 9th day of May 2015 for the election of one Mayor-at-large, and one Councilmember for Precinct 5 and appearing as a result of such canvass that the following named persons received the following numbers of votes for:

And further appearing from such canvass that Neddie Pearl Lang-Moore received the highest number of votes cast for Councilmember Precinct 5.

WHEREAS, the City Secretary has certified that no names were to be placed on a list of write-in candidates for the ballot and there were no propositions to appear on the ballot in said election; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Marlin, Texas:

- Part 1: That Mayor-At-Large Elizabeth Nelson: and Councilmember Precinct 5 Neddie Moore, is declared the duly elected Mayor and Councilmember to serve a two (2) year term of office that expires with the 2017 May Election.
- Part 2: That all of those above named as Mayor and Councilmembers shall be sworn into office in the same manner provided for candidates elected at the election.
- Part 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon adoption and declare an emergency.
