

RESOLUTION NO. 15-025

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDING THROUGH THE  
TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, TEXAS CAPITAL FUND

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Marlin as follows:

SECTION 1.

The City Council has reviewed and hereby authorizes submission of an application for the elimination of slum and blight conditions:

Boundaries - See Exhibit A:

North: Coleman Street

South: Rose Street

East: Wood Street

West: Williams Street

The infrastructure is inadequate to meet the needs of the area, including deteriorated walkways and steps, absence of accessibility (ramps and handrails) for persons with disabilities to commercial and other public buildings in the area, and inadequate lighting in the central area of the City.

The activities are:

- Downtown Revitalization Improvements \$135,000
- Award Administration \$15,000

SECTION 2.

The City Council has reviewed and hereby agrees to comply with all assurances executed in connection with the application and, if funded the award.

SECTION 3.

All funds will be used in accordance with all applicable federal, state, local and programmatic requirements including but not limited to procurement, environmental review, labor standards, real property acquisition, and civil rights requirements.

SECTION 4.

The City Council directs and designates the Mayor as the City's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the City's participation in the Texas Community Development Block Grant Program.

SECTION 5.

That it further be stated that the City of Marlin is committing \$45,000.00 from its General Fund as a cash contribution toward the Engineering, Administrative, Lighting and Sidewalk activities of this economic development project.
