



CITY MANAGER

Located in central Texas, Marlin (pop. 6,000) is a rural, county seat town located within the Waco Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). Located halfway between Dallas and Austin, Marlin is ideally situated for future growth.

Incorporated in 1866, the City of Marlin operates under a home-rule charter. The City Council is comprised of a mayor and six councilmembers elected from single-member districts. The city has approximately 50 fulltime employees. Under policy direction from City Council, the City Manager is responsible for promoting the City Council's goals and ensuring that policies are effectively and efficiently implemented and enforced.

A bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university in public administration or other applicable field is required. Competitive candidates should have at least seven to ten years of senior public sector management experience, such as five to seven years management experience as a city manager/administrator or an assistant or a department director from a city larger or similar in size.
