

ORDINANCE # 2016-025

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CLERK OF THE MUNICIPAL COURT OF RECORD.

WHEREAS the Marlin Municipal Court of Record has been created in accordance with Chapter 30 of the Texas Government Code and section 30.00009 of the Texas Government Code provides that “the governing body shall by ordinance provide for the appointment of a clerk of the municipal courts of record”;

WHEREAS the Clerk is a position of importance within the organization and operation of the Marlin Municipal Court of Record and fulfills his/her duties and responsibilities under the direction and supervision of the Municipal Court Judge; and,

WHEREAS the City Manager is the administrative head of the municipal government and has the general power to employ and discharge employees of the City;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS THAT:

Section 1. The Clerk of the Municipal Court of Record shall be appointed by the City Manager with the advice and consent of the Municipal Judge.

Section 2. In the event that the City Manager and Municipal Judge cannot concur on an appointment and this is communicated to the City Council, the City Council shall make such appointment.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be published and become effective in accordance with state law.
