## Resolution 2016-026

## A resolution of the City Council of the City of Marlin authorizing a capital expenditure in excess of \$2,000.

WHEREAS, it is officially found and determined that the physical upkeep and appearance of the Water Treatment Plant is of utmost importance to the City of Marlin, and

WHEREAS, efforts to maintain the grounds by contract services have been ineffective and City maintenance personnel are already overloaded, and

WHEREAS, Water Treatment Plant personnel would be able to perform this important service on a time-available basis if a machine was consistently available for their use, and

WHEREAS, the 2016-2017 Budget was developed with the purchase of a tractor-mower provided for in the Water Treatment Plant budget, and

WHEREAS, competitive quotes were obtained from five area equipment dealerships.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN THAT THE WATER TREATMENT PLANT BE AUTHORIZED TO PURCHASE A TRACTOR-MOWER FROM TIPTON INTERNATIONAL FOR THE LOWEST QUOTE OF \$19,925.
