

RESOLUTION No. 17-001

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS DESIGNATING THE 2016 CITY OBSERVED HOLIDAYS.

WHEREAS, the City of Marlin personnel policy states that the Mayor and City Council will annually designate the official paid holidays that are to be observed by the City of Marlin; and

WHEREAS, it is customary for the holidays that fall on Saturday to be taken Friday and those that fall on Sunday to be taken Monday; and employees required to work a shift on the holiday will be provided extra compensation as set out in the personnel policy, and

WHEREAS, employees who are members of religious faiths which celebrate widely recognized religious holidays that are not City holidays, as approved by supervisor, may take leave for those days and charge such against annual vacation leave.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council that the following dates are hereby designated as official paid Holidays for the City of Marlin, Texas:

January 16, 2017	Monday	Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
February 20, 2017	Monday	President's Day
April 14, 2017	Friday	Good Friday
May 29, 2017	Monday	Memorial Day
June 16, 2017	Friday	Juneteenth
July 4, 2017	Tuesday	Independence Day
September 4, 2017	Monday	Labor Day
November 10, 2017	Friday	Veteran's Day Observation
November 23-24, 2017	Thursday/Friday	Thanksgiving Day/Day After
December 25-26, 2017	Monday/Tuesday	Christmas Day/ Day After

Two additional personal leave days will be provided for the 2017 calendar year.
