

RESOLUTION No. 13-006

WHEREAS, The City of Marlin City Council finds it in the best interest of the citizens of Marlin, Texas, that the Marlin COPsync Project be operated for the 2014; and

WHEREAS, City of Marlin City Council agrees to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program (JAG), 420.5.C.3751 (a) grant application; and

WHEREAS, City of Marlin, Texas agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice funds, City of Marlin City Council assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, City of Marlin City Council designates Marlin City Manager as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant on behalf of the applicant agency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that City of Marlin City Council approves submission of the grant application for the Marlin COPsync Project to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
