Description

Police Chief: Under the general direction of the City Council, will directly manage and coordinate the daily financial and operational activities of the department. Command and instruct subordinate officers in patrol methods, code of criminal procedure, report writing, community policing. Provides direction and assumes command of major incidents. The position is accountable for the effective management, operations, and supervision of assigned staff. The selected individual must have successfully completed the basic police academy, pass the TCOLE exam, possess an ADVANCED peace officer certification and must satisfactorily complete a basic reading and writing exam and review board. The Chief of Police becomes a non-probationary manager upon completion of six months of service to the Marlin community. This is a full-time position that is focused on police education, enforcement, and community-oriented policing. The City offers excellent benefits including paid holidays, vacation/sick leave, health, dental, life, disability insurance, and TMRS retirement. Pay rate of \$25hr., uniforms, equipment, phone, and vehicle are provided.

REQUIRED EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

10 years' experience as a police officer with a department of comparable or larger size; and 3 years' experience as a police Lieutenant or above with a department of comparable or larger size. High School Diploma or GED with 12 hours credit in core subjects from an accredited college or university with a minimum 2.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale. An Associate degree in Criminal Justice or related field (**Bachelor's preferred**)

OTHER REQUIREMENTS:

Must be willing to commit to 3 years of service to the MPD. Applicants must meet all licensing standards for appointment as a peace officer in the State of Texas. Candidates must undergo a thorough background investigation and pass an interview, a medical exam, drug screening and psychological exam.
